


## Hire Tvals comes equipped with:

- Fridge box on the drawbar
- Triangular awning with poles, pegs & guy ropes
- Table and bench seat
- Mattress protector
- Non slip mat for inside the tent area and a door mat
- Food grade hose and tap fittings for refilling the water tank
- 1 spade
- Plastic hand basin and bucket
- 2 saucepans, 1 frying pan, toaster, kettle
- Cooking utensils including vegetable knife, tin opener, wooden & serving spoons, potato peeler, tongs, egg flip, scissors, grater, bowls and colander
- Gas gun, pot holder, heat mat, cutting board
- Cutlery and crockery for four (if you need more please let us know)
- Dish rack, detergent, sponge and cleaning agent
- 2 Tea towels, broom, dust pan and brush, clothes pegs
- One 12v outlet adaptor
- 15 amp power lead (15m)
- 2x4L gas cylinders. The 2<sup>nd</sup> one is always full. The 1<sup>st</sup> one will be partially used.



**Chairs, pillows, linen and bedding not supplied**

**Cooking/eating gear is stored in 2x30L boxes. There is room for 3 more 35L boxes (max height 28cm, not supplied)**

## Tvals are fitted with

- DO35 tow hitch (we supply the coupling that bolts onto your hayman reese or flat hitch)
- Anderson plug for charging the battery while travelling
- Electric brakes and on board brake controller
- 240V inlet
- Battery charger
- 120w Solar panel and 100AH battery
- Jockey wheel (swing away)
- Stainless steel kitchen including sink with storage space and cutlery drawer
- Light over the kitchen
- 108L water tank (filled); hand pump and electric pump
- Queen size bed
- Four interior multi directional LED lights over the bed
- Fire extinguisher, smoke detector
- Interior roof storage for clothes and some linen (carry shoes in a sports bag). Toilet bag fits beside mattress
- Interior side wall pockets for extra storage ie iPad, books, maps, glasses etc.
- Curtains over tinted window

## Optional extras at extra cost

- 32L fridge @ \$30 per week, \$25 a long weekend and \$20 a weekend
- Shower tent and 12v shower @ \$25 per week or part thereof
- Fuel or water jerry cans \$5 each per week

## Charging Tvan battery

- The battery is trickle charged continuously via the solar panel on sunny days.
- To charge the battery while driving you will need an anderson plug and wiring to your vehicle's battery (to the second battery is the best configuration). *An anderson plug is not essential when hiring; just be aware that the sun may be your only source of energy. Pin 2 on your electrical plug must be live.*
- To charge the battery using 240v power connect the 15 amp extension lead to 240V power supply to the Tvan's external power point. The on board battery charger monitors the rate of charge and will cut out when the battery is fully charged. We recommend you do this regularly (every 4-5 days) if you are running a fridge in the Tvan especially if you don't have an anderson plug.

## Tvan cleaning instructions

- Wipe floor of tent area with a damp sponge on the last morning
- Fresh water hose outside of tent **only** if very dusty or sandy. Do not use any soaps or detergents on canvas
- Hard surfaces – use soft cloth or sponge and household detergent. (Car Lovers works well)
- High pressure hose underside especially if you have been over muddy or any sandy terrain
- **Do not use brushes or scourers on any surface including the stainless steel kitchen**

**NB: Tvals returned dirty will incur a cleaning levy of \$250.00 deducted from your security deposit**
